

### **Friendly Reminders:**

To help keep out Summer Program running smoothly, we are asking our parents to please help us with the following:

- If your child is feeling under the weather, please keep them home.
- If someone other than a parent is picking up, please notify the staff; if the person is already on your emergency contact list, we just need to have a phone call giving verbal permission. If the person isn't on any forms, we would need to have written permission from a parent of guardian to allow that person to pick up. We would need that persons; full name, physical address and phone number. Please remind your emergency contact people to please bring their ID's. We will ask to see them.
